An original sketch of the dial of Konstantin Chaykin's Joker Wristmon. 2023. Drawing on watercolor paper.

A sketch of the dial of Konstantin Chaykin's Joker Wristmon, the first model in the Wrist Monsters collection. The watch was introduced at the BaselWorld exhibition in 2017 and made its creator world-famous. The sketch is drawn with **graphite pencil** and nothing else. When working on it, the master wanted to find a way to depict with nothing but a pencil the effect created by one of the most striking finishing techniques, the guilloche. Thanks to a combination of **different shading techniques**, Konstantin Chaykin managed to achieve exactly that.



SKETCH GAME OF THRONES LOT 9

An original sketch of an unrealized watch project by Konstantin Chaykin. 2022. Watercolor paper, drawing.

A sketch of a Konstantin Chaykin watch with chained graphic hour indication. The drawing is a part of the Phantom Watch series, a collection of sketches of the master's unrealized projects. When working on this potential design, Chaykin was inspired by the popular "Game of Thrones" fantasy TV series. The sketch is extremely detailed. Chaykin managed to fully express the texture of the metal of the case, and the leather of the watchstrap. The smallest parts of the minute indicator, shaped like a steering wheel. Above it the master depicted the barrel of the chain graphic hour indicator with a chain with Roman numerals for links, coiled around it.

A movement with this type of indication is impossible to implement in a wristwatch, so the concept remains just a concept. But Konstantin Chaykin did use the idea in a larger piece, the Lucomorye clock. The idea required a movement with 1119 parts to implement.

An original sketch of **still-unrealized model** from Konstantin Chaykin's Wristmons collection, the Quetzalcoatl. 2023. Pencil and watercolors on watercolor paper.

Konstantin Chaykin is always coming up with new projects for his Wristmons collection. The watchmaker is fascinated by Mexico, its colorful folklore, and the rich culture and history of the indigenous Aztec people who populated Central America in the Middle Ages. In 2022 Chaykin released the Calavera Wristmon, inspired by the Mexican Day of the Dead. This sketch is a result of the constant search for new images and ways of artistic expression. It depicts a Wristmon portraying Quetzalcoatl, the Aztec fertility god. He appeared as a winged serpent with colorful feathers. Using fine watercolor brushstrokes, Chaykin managed to create a striking image which may one day become a new watch.

A sketch of Konstantin Chaykin's Mouse King Wristmon, released in 2020 in celebration of the **year of the Rat in Chinese calendar.** The master was inspired by Ernst Theodor Amadeus Hoffman fairy tale "The Nutcracker and the Mouse King". The sketch is done in pencil and watercolors. The watchmaker was able to use these tools to depict the guilloche technique which was used on the Wrismon's dial. The dial was finished with **three different types of guilloche**, and the master found watercolor shades which produced a very similar effect. The texture of the matte surface of the titanium case is also exquisitely convincing.

SKETCH GENIUS TEMPORIS BLUE ARROW

An original sketch of Konstantin Chaykin's Genius Temporis Blue Arrow watch. **One of a kind**. Made in 2022. Cardboard, pencil, watercolors.

The sketch depicts the steel-cased Genius Temporis Blue Arrow watch, the first version of Konstantin Chaykin's **famous "one-hand" model.** The watch features a unique complication, switchable hour and minute indication with the same hand. This invention was patented by Chaykin. The Genius Temporis Blue Arrow model was first introduced at the BaselWorld-2014 exhibition.

Unlike the serial-produced Genius Temporis, this model is distinguished by a restrained, **laconic 1930s-style design**. The dial is marked with Arabic numerals in deep, rich blue color, and a single clock hand in blued steel, shaped like a crossbow bolt. The sketch perfectly represents the finish of individual parts and the balanced yet striking blue-and-grey design of the model.

The project has a system distributed in three sections: each eye has operation to give hour and minute respectively, additionally the **tongue has manual operation** from one of the crowns.

This is why the initial proposal for the hour movement is a winding mechanism that has a power reserve of approximately 7 days. The mechanism is made with materials such as bronze and stainless steel with the particularity of displaying hours and minutes. The mechanism is designed and manufactured by a **German watch company**.

The Konstantin Chaykin brand auction held jointly with Ineichen is a rare opportunity to purchase a new Wristmon on the day of its release, completely bypassing the waiting list.
